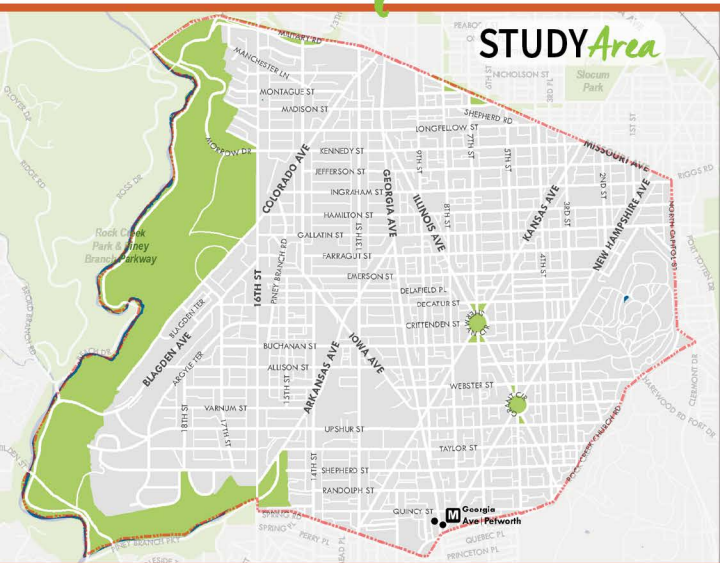

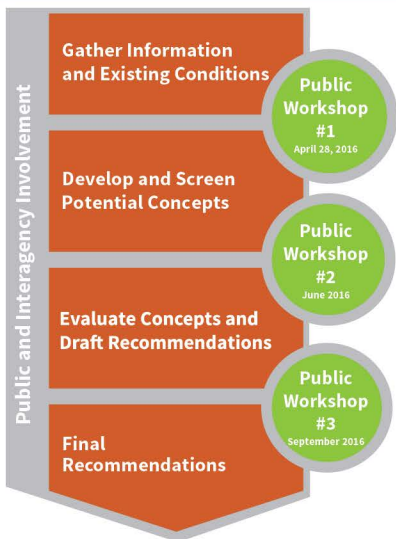
Livability
