

Issues



- Visibility challenges from intersection angles, parking near corners, and changes in elevation
- Bicyclists widely cite discomfort due to speeding

Opportunities



- Green infrastructure treatments for traffic calming and stormwater management
- Redesign intersections to shorten crossing distances and improve visibility
- Connect Kansas Avenue bike lanes to Gallatin-Hamilton lanes east of New Hampshire, using wayfinding, signage and other treatments
- Complete the bike connection from Georgia to Spring (moveDC recommendation), though possibly with other treatments than bike lanes
- DDOT is developing a tool to measure the comfort level of bicyclists on bike facilities, which could be used to inform further improvements
