




## WHAT WE HEARD FROM YOU PUBLIC WORKSHOP #2 & ENGAGEMENT EVENTS


At the second public workshop, we presented opportunity areas for improvements. We heard general support for the recommendations, with urging to go further. We listened and refined the recommendations for bicycle facilities, sidewalk gaps and pedestrian enhancements, green infrastructure, and traffic calming. The result of this effort was a draft recommendation booklet that was presented at two Community Engagement Events (CEEs) in August. A survey was available online and at the CEEs to gather feedback and thoughts on the draft recommendations. The below charts show the results of the survey:










■ Like ■ Neutral ■ Dislike









The results of the survey show general support for the recommendations, such as infrastructure to enhance pedestrian safety at Grant and Sherman Circles, additional traffic signs and signals, curb extensions, bicycle facilities, and green infrastructure. We heard the need for more traffic calming, and better access to public spaces such as Rock Creek Park and other neighborhood green spaces.
